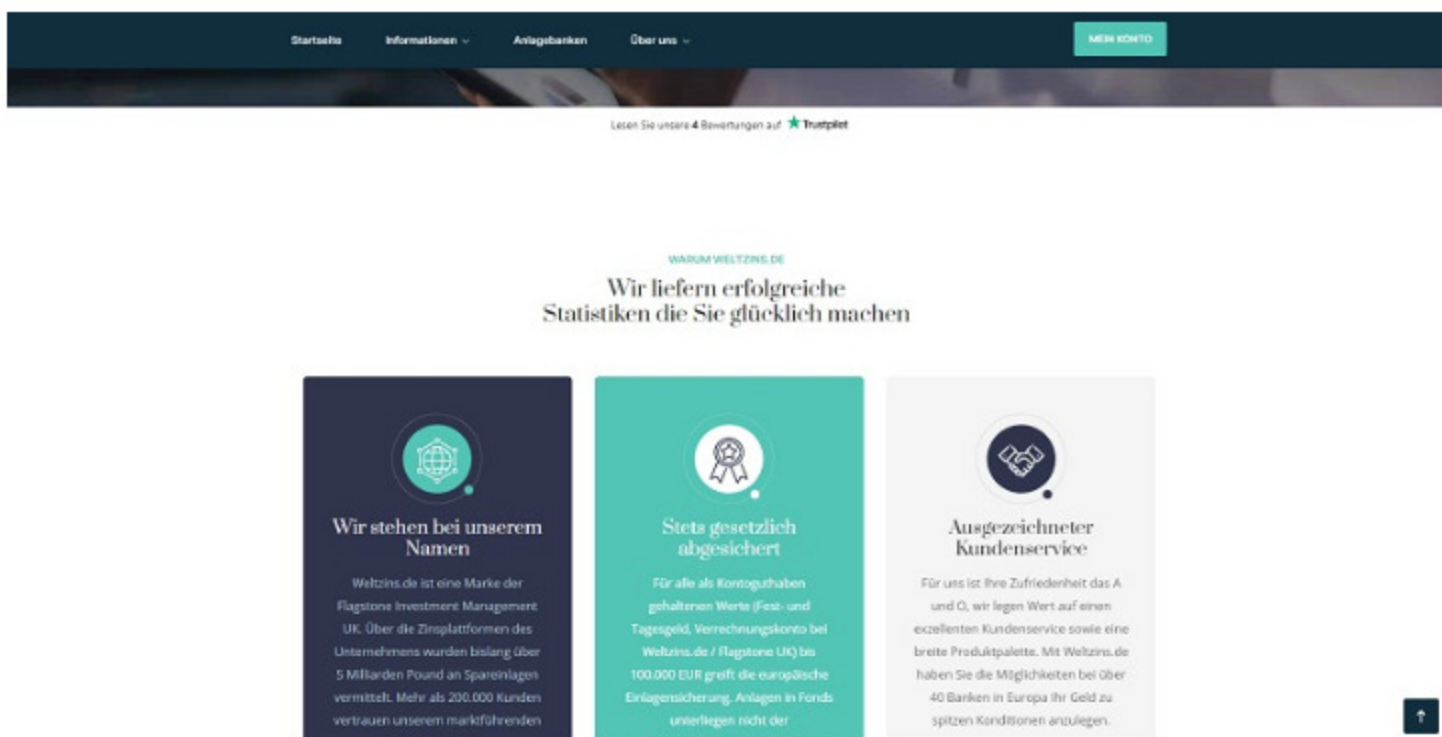

This is a strong indicator that it is a scam.

Weltzins domain name verification.

It is also a strong signal that it is a fraud. **Weltzins** has his domain name which is less than 5 years old. What concerns us is that it is a domain name that has just been created while **Weltzins** claims to be a leader in the financial market. This is a first signal that directs us to a scam.

The most important thing for a financial company is to have one or more licenses regulated according to the countries to which it offers its services. Unfortunately for **Weltzins**, He does not have regulated licenses and therefore does not have the right to charge you money for a financial service. **The Financial Conduct Authority (UK)** has issued a public warning against **Weltzins**. He is on a European blacklist which confirms to us that it is a scam.

What are the chances of getting your money back?
